We Are One Earth Family

On Sunday, October 4, Delmar, Preston, and First United Methodist Churches will gather at Delmar United Methodist Church to celebrate World Communion Sunday. Our theme is "We Are One Earth Family." I hope you will join us for this time of shared worship, prayer, and Holy Communion.

World Communion Sunday began in 1933 at Shadyside Presbyterian Church in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The Rev. Hugh Thompson Kerr and his congregation sought to help Christians recognize their connection with one another across denominational lines. They chose Communion as a visible expression of that unity. In 1940, the Federal Council of Churches adopted the observance, helping it spread to churches worldwide. Today, many congregations celebrate it on the first Sunday of October. That history speaks to us here in Iowa. We worship in three congregations, each with its own people, traditions, and gifts. Yet when we gather at Christ's table, we remember that we belong to something greater. Across countries, cultures, and languages, Christians share the bread and cup and proclaim the love of Jesus Christ. Our theme also invites us to carry the spirit of Communion beyond the church doors. If we are one family on earth, we are called to welcome strangers, care for our neighbors, listen across our differences, and seek peace amid division. The table reminds us that God's grace is both a gift to receive and a gift to share.

Please join us on Sunday, October 4, 2026, at Delmar United Methodist Church, 305 Delmar Ave., Delmar, IA 52037. I look forward to worshipping together as one family in Christ.

WIC

The government Women, Infants and Children (WIC) clinic takes place in our church the first Wednesday and Thursday of each month. Our church supplements the assistance WIC provides for families with 12 diapers, a package of wipes, a book, and the clothing we have available. Another important part of our ministry is visiting with the families who come to WIC and making them feel welcome in our church.
